Potential Career Areas for Internships:

Animal Care: Rotation sites include veterinarian offices, day care centers, and animal training facilities.

Athletic Training: Rotation sites include high school sporting events.

Banking: Rotation sites include local banks and credit unions.

Education: Rotation sites include elementary, middle or high school classrooms.

Legal: Rotation sites include local law firms.

Management: Rotation sites include local businesses, hotel/restaurant facilities, and other companies.

Political Science: Rotation sites include local political representative campaign offices.

Performing Arts: Rotation sites can include local theater companies or school settings.

Real Estate: Rotation sites can include local real estate companies.
